## FISHING POLICY AND REGISTRATION MEADOW LAKES CAMPGROUND

Annual Fee - **\$25** for head of household, **\$10** for each additional immediate family member (spouse or minor child) living in the same household. Ages fifteen and under are free.

**DUE TO ENFORCEMENT AND ABUSE ISSUES, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING VERY CLOSELY!**

I will notify the Kansas District office by phone at 316-686-2332 prior to each and every use of the campground area for fishing. After business hours I will leave a message on the voice recorder indicating my name and the day I/we plan to fish.

This year no cards will be issued and you are not required to produce your registration letter or form. Enforcement will be made by campground staff personnel. You will be asked your name and names of those with you. This information will be verified by our phone and registration records. If you are not registered you are trespassing. If you are in violation of fishing rules or policies, fishing privileges will be terminated immediately. Registration fees will not be refunded.

I have read and will abide by the rules listed on the *Fishing Policy and Registration Form*. I understand that this registration is for day use fishing only. Reservations for overnight camping, showering and use of the RV, Gazebo and Pavilion areas must be made separately through the Kansas District office. Restroom privileges are for all groups. I understand the use of these facilities is at my own risk. I will leave the facilities and grounds clean and in good condition.

### *Fishing Policies Continued*

- **ALL TRASH** is to be bagged and placed in the dumpster located in the rear pavilion parking lot.
  - **NO** fish cleaning in or near any building or in the restrooms. If you clean your fish throw the remains in the lake.
  - **SHOWER / CAMPING / SLEEPING / OVERNIGHT** privileges are **NOT** included with a fishing registration.
  - **USE** of the RV, Gazebo and Pavilion areas (except restrooms) is **NOT** included with a fishing registration.
  - **DO NOT** give the fishing registration gate lock combination to anyone that is not registered with you.
  - **DO NOT** move picnic tables or benches from their designated locations.
  - **DO NOT** drive or park on grass or field areas. Park in designated parking areas or **ONE CAR LENGTH** off roadway.
  - **NO PETS** allowed on the property.
  - **NO MOTORIZED SPORT VEHICLES on the campground property** (“sport vehicles” include motorcycles, mini-bikes, go-karts, 4-wheelers and ATV’s). **ALL VEHICLES**, including pop-ups, campers, and RV’s, may be driven and parked **only on roads, parking areas, and RV camping spots** with hook-ups.
  - **BOAT USAGE:** Since there is no boat ramp, only small boats are allowed. **No gas-powered motors.** Do not back boat trailers into the water. Boats must contain lifejackets or PFD for each person. Those under 18 must be wearing a PFD in boat at all times.
  - **NO TROT LINES**      **FISH SIZE & LIMITS:**
    - **Largemouth Bass:** limit 3; minimum length 12." Please release all bass over 18" unless you plan to mount them. Take your camera.    **Crappie:** limit 5; minimum length 10."    **Channel Catfish:** limit 5; minimum length 10.    **All Others:** no limits on number or size.
  - **NO SWIMMING OR DIVING.** Modest dress is assumed.
  - **NO SMOKING, use of tobacco, alcohol (including beer), or controlled substances** allowed on the property. **Usage of the same will terminate the privilege of access to and use of the facilities.**

- For your convenience, there is a separate gate lock for those with fishing registrations.
  - For your convenience, you can now fish anytime at your leisure. (Don’t forget to call the office each time.)
  - For your convenience, you don’t have to take your trash, just bag it and put it in the dumpster.
  - For your convenience, since our ponds are privately owned, managed and stocked, state fishing licenses are not required. Only the forms and fees we collect are required.
