Follow all written and posted policies and procedures. They are there for your safety.

All campground use (fishing, tent camping, RV camping, gazebo, lodge, and pavilion) must be reserved and approved through the district office. Always have confirmation with you at the campground to present to authorized campground personnel.

GENERAL POLICY -

Each group is responsible for cleanup of the grounds and buildings as specified below.

- **FIRE in designated areas and proper containers only.** Please do not leave an open fire unattended. Put out all fires before leaving.
- **TRASH:** Remove all trash from property. **TAKE IT WITH YOU. There is no trash service.**
- **NO SWIMMING OR DIVING.** Modest dress is assumed.
- **NO SMOKING, use of tobacco, alcohol (including beer), or controlled substances** allowed on the property. Usage of the same will terminate the privilege of access to and use of the facilities.
- **NO PETS** allowed on the property or in the house.
- **NO MOTORIZED SPORT VEHICLES on the campground property** ("sport vehicles" include motorcycles, minibikes, go-karts, 4-wheelers and ATV's).
ALL VEHICLES, including pop-ups, campers, and RV's, may be driven and parked only on roads, parking areas, and RV camping spots with hook-ups. Please do not drive or park on grass or field areas.

FISHING POLICY - An annual fishing permit (\$20 fee) is required allowing limited day use fishing privileges. Permit must be presented for identification to authorized persons at the camp.

- **Boat Usage:** Since there is no boat ramp, only small boats are allowed. **No gas-powered motors.** Do not back boat trailers into the water. Boats must contain lifejackets or PFD for each person. Those under 18 must be wearing a PFD in boat at all times.
- **Fish size and limits:**
Largemouth Bass: limit 3; minimum length 12." Please release all bass over 18" unless you plan to mount them. Take your camera.
Crappie: limit 5; minimum length 10."
Channel Catfish: limit 5; minimum length 10.
All Others: no limits on number or size.
- **NO TROT LINES** allowed.

FISHING PRIVILEGES - Fishing privileges are included in the fee for all group reservations at the campground (lodge, pavilion, tent camping and RV camping) except *Day-Use*, however, all fish are to be thrown back unless you have a fishing permit (see fishing policy) OR you cook and eat the fish at the campground. Only fishing permit holders may take designated fish they have caught from the premises.

CANOES - \$15 each (2 available) per day. State of Kansas boating safety regulations must be followed. PFD's are provided.

DAY-USE of grounds (no building or gazebo use), \$3 per vehicle. NO FISHING. Get self pay permit at entrance.

GAZEBO SHELTER - \$10 per day, \$15 for overnight. Picnic tables are not to be removed from the shelter.

TENT CAMPING - Reservations must be made in advance at the district office. Tent fee is \$5 per night per unit unless a group event reservation is made. Group tent camping fee is \$25. Pavilion restrooms are available for your use. Tent camping is not allowed on the east side of the lake in the area around the lodge. Take all trash with you when you leave. There is no trash service at the campground.

RV CAMPING - Reservations must be made in advance at the district office. RV hook-up fee is \$9 per unit per night. Group rate is available at \$8 per unit per night for 4 or more units. Pop-ups, campers, and RV must be parked only in RV parking provided with hook-ups. No driving or parking on grass or field areas. Pavilion restrooms are available for your use. Take all trash with you when you leave. There is no trash service at the campground.

PAVILION USE - Reservations must be made in advance at the district office. Fee is \$75 per day or \$95 for overnight. Each person/group is responsible for cleaning up after themselves.

- **Air conditioning:** Air conditioner is to be turned off when you leave. Make sure ceiling fans and all lights are off and windows are closed.
- **Supplies and furnishing in pavilion:** Meeting room with tables & chairs for about 120 people. Covered outdoor area for about 200 people. Small kitchen provided. If we must clean up the kitchen after you there will be an additional \$15 kitchen fee assessed! (This is at our discretion.) Bathrooms: multiple showers
- **Cleaning:** Sweep all floors and mop if needed. Clean up restrooms. Fold and return tables and chairs to stack. Empty waste containers and take all trash with you. There is no trash service. Clean outside grill if you use it. Take a final trip through to make sure everything is clean and you haven't forgotten anything (especially food you have left in the refrigerator).

You will need to provide your own table service, towels, dish soap, toilet tissue, trash bags, paper towels, matches, and flashlight.

LODGE USE - Reservations must be made in advance at the district office. Maximum overnight occupancy for the lodge is 6 people. Fee for one or two people is \$75 1st night, \$40 for each additional night, limit of 5 nights. Add \$9 per additional person, per night (children 5 and under are free). \$75 day use only fee for small groups.

- **Wood Stove:** Please do not leave stove burning unattended. Be sure fire is out before leaving.
- **Air conditioning:** Air conditioner is to be turned off when you leave. During November thru April furnace should be left on heat but set to 50 degrees. Make sure ceiling fans and all lights are off.
- **Supplies and furnishings in cabin:**
Full kitchen, 8' table and 8 chairs. Feel free to use any kitchen appliances or furnishings. If you do the dishes and clean up there is no charge. If we clean up after you there will be an additional \$15 kitchen fee assessed! (This is at our discretion.)
Beds: One king bed, two twin beds in loft with bedding provided. Trundle day bed (sleeps 2) for sleeping bag use (bring your own bag).
Outside Grill: clean after each use
- **Cleaning:** Lodge fees include laundering of bedding and towels, trash disposal, and cleaning **other than kitchen** (see kitchen policy above). There are cleaning supplies under the kitchen sink and a vacuum if you have an accident. Clean outside grill if you use it. Take a final trip through to make sure you haven't forgotten anything.
